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Donations and Support Received October 2023 – July 2024

The Nutrition Society's Supporters' Policy commits the Society's Trustees to annually, transparently, disclose the donations received (subject to any contractual and commercially sensitive restrictions) and how they have been used to support the Society's activities. Between October 2023 and July 2024, various organisations have supported the Society with donations, totalling £44,650. This currently only represents 2.97% of the Society's charitable income in 2024.

The majority of the support received occurred during the Summer Congress, held 2-5 July 2024 in Belfast. The funds received helped defray the overall cost of the Congress, ensuring that delegate fees were kept as low as practicable. That said, the Congress still required an overall subsidy from the Society, in addition to these supporters contributions, of £59,000, to cover all of the costs.
